For all articles not specified in this Short Version, the Standard Regulations for Events of the NEZ Championship for Crosskart Drivers are valid. The Standard Regulations are distributed to each competitor in the NEZ Championship by his ASN. They are also posted on the Official Notice Board of each event. ENTRY FEES

The entry fee includes electricity and environment:

Participants in the contest do so at their own risk. Thus, the DASU, organizer or officer can't be held responsible for personal injury or property damage that may be affected by a contest. Through the registration, the competitor has agreed to the personal data of the person concerned registered in the competition organizer's data register and that the organizer, in the course of his activity, publishes the name information regardless of the media form.

V. CHECKING

ADMINISTRATIVE CHECKING

Only drivers must report to administrative checking which will be held at Nysumbanen.

SCRUTINEERING

Any Crosskart taking part in the Event must be presented by the driver or his entrant to scrutineering, which will be held at Nysumbanen, on the 08.10.2021 and 09.10.2021, (in accordance with the given timetable). Any Crosskart arriving after the closure of scrutineering may be refused permission to start. The organiser may provide a special period for scrutineering for competitors who arrive after the closure of scrutineering.

VI. RUNNING OF THE EVENT

DRIVERS BRIEFING.

Drivers of those Crosskarts, which are eligible to take part in the race, must be present throughout the entire Drivers' Briefing. The Briefing will be held in English.

PRACTICE

Free practice is not obligatory. Practice Saturday 1 x 3 laps. Warm up Sunday 1 x 2 laps.

QUALIFYING

The event is implemented in accordance with Crosskart NEZ Championship Competition Regulations 2021. Starting order for the qualification heats and finals is as follows: Mini, 85cc, 125 cc, Senior (+40), 250 cc, 650 cc, Xtreme junior and Xtreme.

The qualifying heats will be 4 (3½) laps.

Mini and Xtreme will drive a special racetrack.

Speed control will be done at Mini and 85 cc with laser pistol type "Bushnell Speed Radar Gun".

FINALS

The finals will be 6 (5½) laps.

The starters are until 9 Crosskart in 3 rows. The start grid 3-3-3. In the front row line 1 + 3 + 5 is used. The second row line 2 + 4 + 6 is used. The third row line 1 + 3 + 5 is used.

Number of finals:

Number of final heats is decided of number of competitors in each class which is eligible to start in a final.

A-final at minimum 2 competitors

B-final at minimum 13 competitors

C-final at minimum 20 competitors

D-final at minimum 27 competitors

The 2 best cars from the previous final are moved up to the next final.

Qualification to the final

Point qualification shall be done in the following way:

A qualification round victory gives 10 points, then 7, 5, 3, 2, 1. The sum of points from all the 3 qualification rounds is ground for qualification to the final. The driver with the highest points starts from position 1 according to the circuit license. The driver with the second highest points starts from position 2 and so on. There is not allowed to choose other position than the one given from the list.

DNS = 0 pts, DNF = 0 pts, DNQ = 0 pts, Overtaken = DNF

In the case of two or more drivers receive the same point; separation happens according to the following: 1. Number of victory points, seconds and so on 2. The driver's place in qualification round 3. 3. The driver's place in qualification round 2. 4. The driver's place in qualification round 1. 5. The higher position in overall classification of the season, secondary is last season overall classification. 6. If no one on the previous list it is decided by lottery.

Drivers must have completed (and received the chequered flag) in minimum 1 qualification round in order to be eligible to start in a final.

VII. PARC FERME - RESULTS - PROTESTS

PARC FERME

Immediately after the finals all karts must be parked in the parc ferme.

If a kart is not parked in parc ferme due to fault of driver – the driver will be excluded from the meeting. The karts shall remain in the parc ferme until released by decision of the Clerk of the Course.

Only Scrutineers and competitors invited by Chief Scrutineer are allowed to be in parc ferme.

RESULTS

All results will be posted on the official notice board immediately after each heat as soon as they are complete.

The results will be posted after last final on official notice board.

PROTESTS - APPEALS

All protests will be lodged in accordance with the Code.

All protests must be made in writing and handed to the Clerk of the Course, or in their absence any of the Stewards of the meeting, together with the sum of €300. If the protest requires the dismantling and reassembly of different parts of a cart, the claimant must make a deposit of €1000.

Competitors have the right to appeal, the amount of the appeal fee is €1000.

IX. OTHER INFORMATION

FIRE EXTINGUISHERS

Each driver is responsible for ensuring that a fire extinguisher (6 kg) is available within the team area inside the paddock.

PROTECTION OF THE ENVIRONMENT

Each driver is requested to ensure that a plastic sheet (minimum dimensions 4 metres by 5) is spread on the ground in the place reserved for the team where work is to be done on the kart, in order to prevent any pollution in case of an accidental leak, etc.

Driver must clean after himself the parking place.

PADDOCK

Please be careful if you use barbeque in the paddock.

GARBAGE

Please sort the garbage according to the instructions provided.

PAPERS

No papers (final instruction) will be sent forward to the drivers. Look at www.mnj.dk.

DRIVERS'LIAISON OFFICER

The Drivers' Liaison Officer will be recognisable by special vest. He may be reached near race center.

AUTHORISATION

Dansk Automobil Sports Union has agreed those Regulations.
